Ohio Northern University had a general education plan from 2011-16 that was based on seven learning outcomes. Students met the requirements of the general education plan by taking courses that specifically addressed these learning outcomes, known as tagged courses. Students had to complete four required courses (ENGL 1221, transition experience, the extradisciplinary seminar, and the capstone sequence) plus earn a total of 20 tags in the seven learning outcomes. Students supported the general education assessment by submitting artifacts to Taskstream.

Beginning in 2016-17, ONU's general education plan has ten learning outcomes. This plan requires students to take ten courses plus the capstone sequence. The writing seminar, transition experience, and the seminar course are part of these requirements. General education assessment will be completed by the faculty instructors of gen ed courses.

Students who began their studies at ONU prior to 2016-17 will be transitioned to the new general education plan as follows. A list of courses approved for each learning outcome is available in the student's Degreeworks audit. We have designed this transition to make sure all students are not delayed in completing the general education plan.

- 8. Aesthetics: One course from the list or one tag from prior outcome #7
- 9. Civics/Ethics: One course from the list or one tag from prior outcome #6
- 10. Diversity Seminar: Either EXDS 2001 seminar or one of the new approved Diversity seminars (Spring 2017 and on)
